Making a burse with edge trim

- 1 Back face pieces with iron-on interfacing.
- 2. Turn front piece, interfacing up and find center of the piece. Mark the center lines vertically and horizonally.
- 3. Measure and mark lines $4\frac{1}{2}$ " from the center line on each side.
- 4. Transfer markings to the right side of the front piece by machine basting along the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " lines all around.
- 5. On the right side lay outside edge of the galloon along the machine basting beginning on the bottom hinge edge of the burse. Stitch.
- 6. Stitch the linen lining along the top edge of the burse pieces 1/8" from galloon. (Note: the straight of grain or pattern of the burse should be parallel to the burse opening. The opening should be on the right when facing you.)
- 7. Stitch the sides 1/8" from the galloon. On the back pieces proceed as usual.
