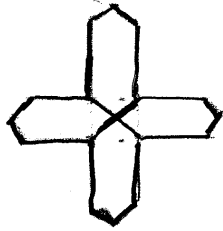


CROSSES

This method makes a nice looking cross but doesn't work well with some heavy galloons.



Finished cross

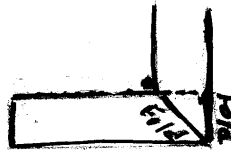


1. Cut 2 pieces of galloon the same size.

2. Fold in half right sides together.

3. Then take top half and fold at right angle - mark inward corner .

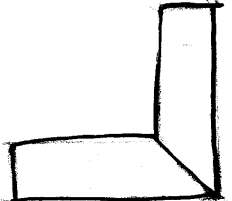
4. Then straighten the galloon out- and mark and stitch at a 45 /degree angle

5. Open to form a right angle. Press seam open.

6. Make a second like the first

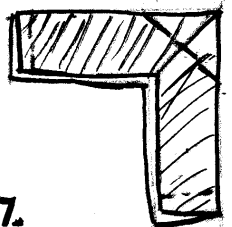

7. Pin the 2 pieces right sides together .Mark and stitch as shown in figure

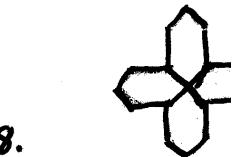
8. Open to form cross. Press seam open.

(May take a couple tries to get it right)

9. To make pointed ends fold the ends in half lengthwise right sides together and stitch across the end. Turn to right side and it will form a point.
